



**Survey Procedures:** The following summary information was compiled from a survey of the 2014-2015 graduating class conducted six months after graduation. Multiple contacts and methods were employed to reach all available graduates for their participation, and to insure the highest rate of validity for this study. The following summary provides information on job placement, employment status, and salaries of students. The data are dependent on the amount of information returned by each graduate.

Half of graduates (51.4%) responded to the survey. Of the graduate respondents, nine in ten (90%) reported being satisfied or very satisfied with the training they received at Blackhawk Technical College. Nearly all respondents available for employment (95%) are employed with an average hourly wage of \$16.58 (35+ hours/week only). Almost three out of four (73%) are employed in a field related to training, with an average hourly wage of \$17.74. Of these, half (53%) are employed at a location within the BTC district, one in six (16%) employed within the state of Wisconsin, and one in nine (11%) employed in another state.
