

The Blackhawk Technical College District is committed to an “open door” policy for admission to the College for all prospective students who meet statutory requirements. High school graduation or the equivalent is usually expected for admission into post-secondary programs at BTC. However, completed application, transcripts, and entrance assessment may also be used in determining admission.

Wisconsin residents will have priority in admissions. Non-Wisconsin residents may be admitted to programs at Blackhawk Technical College after Wisconsin residents, inside and outside the Blackhawk Technical College District, as program space is available. Students who apply for admission under an interstate reciprocity agreement shall be considered for program admission based on the residence category established for students by the terms of the reciprocity agreement.

The President/District Director or designee shall ensure that admissions procedures are kept current with WTCSB policy 502 and WTCS Administrative Code TSC 10 as they may be amended or changed from time to time. The President/District Director or designee shall also ensure that admissions procedures guarantee the fair and equitable treatment of all applicants.
