### **BadgerLink**

This database provides access to magazines, newspapers and a statewide library catalog (WISCAT). It contains EBSCOhost, +20 databases indexing magazine articles. Besides the BTC library web page under the Find Books & AV link, it is available at this address:

### **Health Reference Center Academic**

Use this database to find articles on: fitness, pregnancy, medicine, nutrition, diseases, public health, occupational health and safety, alcohol and drug abuse, HMOs, prescription drugs, etc. The material contained in this database is from both magazines and reference books.

### **Career and Technical Education**

Providing access to more periodicals than any other vo-tech database, it includes indexing for subjects in medicine; nursing, office occupations, and pharmacy. It has full text for more than 400 titles, including *Office Systems*, *Office World News*, and *OfficePro*.

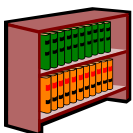
