BadgerLink

This database provides access to magazines, newspapers and a statewide library catalog (WISCAT). It contains EBSCOhost, 24 databases indexing magazine articles—including MEDLINE; Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition; and Nursing and Allied Health Collection: Basic. CINAHL

The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature covers over 1200 professional journals in nursing, 17 allied health disciplines, and health sciences librarianship, with coverage back to 1982. It also indexes healthcare books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, standards of practice, educational software in nursing, audiovisuals, and book chapters. It is the only index that includes all of the nursing titles listed above.

Health Reference Center Academic

Use this database to find articles on: fitness, pregnancy, medicine, nutrition, diseases, public health, occupational health and safety, alcohol and drug abuse, HMOs, prescription drugs, etc. The material contained in this database is intended for informational purposes only.

Career and Technical Education

Providing access to more periodicals than any other vo-tech database, it includes indexing for subjects in medicine; nursing, office occupations, and pharmacy. It has full text for more than 400 titles, including; *Academic Pediatrics, Nursing, Nursing Standard, and Pediatric Nursing*.

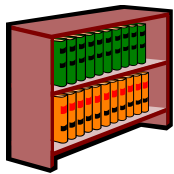
