



Survey Procedures: The information contained within this brochure was compiled from a survey of the 2007-2008 graduating class conducted six months after graduation. A concerted effort was made to reach all available graduates for their participation, and to insure the highest rate of validity for this study. The follow-up study provides information on job placement, employment status, and salaries of students graduating in 2007-2008. These summaries were, of course, dependent on the amount of information returned by each graduate. Of the graduates surveyed 69% responded to the survey. Of those graduates, 98% were satisfied or very satisfied with the training they received at Blackhawk Technical College, 90% are employed with a median hourly wage in related occupations of \$14.21. In addition, all programs reported an average hourly wage in related occupations of \$15.85 per hour, 87.5% of the respondents are working in fields related to their training, and 60.1% are employed in the BTC district while an additional 28.9% were employed elsewhere in Wisconsin.
