- **Central Campus**—midway between Beloit and Janesville with entrances off of Highways 51 and County G
- **Beloit Center**— 50 Eclipse Center, in the Beloit Eclipse Center off of Riverside Drive/Highway 51
- **Center for Transportation Studies**—1740 Highway 14 West - 1/4 mile west of the Highway 14 and 51 intersection
- **Aviation Center**—located at the Southern Wisconsin Regional Airport - one mile south of Janesville on Hwy 51
- **Monroe Campus**— 210 4th Ave. on the northwest side of Monroe

STUDENT PROFILE

- **Numbers**—In 2008-2009, BTC served 11,670 students, which includes:
 - 6,753 in credit & Basic Skills
 - 4,917 in adult non-credit
- **Placement Rates**—90% of BTC's graduating class seeking employment had jobs within six months, 87.5% in jobs directly related to their training
- **Age**—Student population in credit/degree programs averages 29.4 yrs—the largest segment, however, is 19-24 year olds
- **Male/Female**—41% male, 59% female in credit programs. The ratio is almost 50/50 when looking at all BTC students (49.8% male, 50.2% female)

- **Salaries**—2008 *average entry-level hourly wages* for program graduates in related jobs by category:
 - **Associate Degree**—\$16.99
 - **2-Yr. Technical Diploma**—\$13.74
 - **1-Yr. Technical Diploma**—\$15.93
 - **Short-Term Certificate**—\$14.10
